The Program

- Provides students with the opportunity to learn about and develop their leadership skills through guest speakers, selfreflection, and service in the community.
- Four year leadership program open to all Heider students.
 - Level 1: Students learn how leaders create socially responsible organizations.
 - Level 2: Students begin to develop their strengths and identify limitations.
 - Level 3: Students work in the community to further hone their skills.
 - Level 4: Students take on a leadership role in an organization.
- Students serve community in Levels 2 and 3.
- Students reflect on the entire experience in Level 4.

• In the spring semester, student groups are given a \$100 budget to carry out a service project to benefit a local non-profit organization.


