### Who We Are

Founded and run by students of the Creighton University School of Medicine since 2004, the Magis Clinic serves the homeless and uninsured of Omaha.

The Magis Clinic's services are provided by volunteers from Creighton's Medical, Pharmacy, and Physician Assistant Schools. Services include basic acute primary care consultations and follow-up, physical exams, mental health care, STD testing, laboratory services, including basic blood tests, and medications. Magis Clinic volunteers also partner with the Charles Drew Health Center, coordinating their efforts to achieve the mission of the Magis Clinic.



### Who We Serve

The Magis Clinic provides no charge drop-in acute care, psychiatric services, and sexual health services to all men and women, who find themselves homeless or with limited or no access to healthcare resources. The majority of our patient population comes from local homeless shelters, including the Siena-Francis House in which the clinic is located, as well as substance abuse treatment centers. The clinic also see patients free of charge who are not homeless but are otherwise unable to afford adequate healthcare.
