









As a Creighton Global Scholar, you will be well positioned to live, work, compete and collaborate anywhere in the world as a thoughtful, educated and experienced global citizen.

Creighton's Global Scholars Program is a four-year educational and professional development program. It is designed to immerse select students in a variety of cultures for a rich academic, social and service experience where you will build networks with other students, faculty and alumni from around the world. Through language study, specialized coursework, service-learning, research, internships, and interaction with leaders in the global community, Creighton Global Scholars will become experienced global citizens, ready for employment in international organizations upon graduation.

As a Global Scholar, you will complete a minimum of four global experiences during your time at Creighton. These experiences are designed to immerse you in a diverse mix of experiences and traditions that provide a unique and rich lens through which to focus your major studies.

- Two semester-long study abroad experiences
- · Choice of two summer intensive experiences: either two Faculty-Led Programs Away (FLPA) or one FLPA and one Intensive Language Immersion Program or International Internship
- · Six semesters on Creighton's campus
- A special companion seminar each semester to continually integrate global learning into each student's major
- · Additional opportunities are available on-campus and around the world

YOUR GLOBAL CURRICULUM

FRESHMAN YEAR

Your freshman year will begin in July in Sydney, Australia, where you will pursue your major course of study and live in a residential community with all the support you will need to be successful.

Through your experience at the University of Sydney, you will receive a globally-recognized education, with access to world-class facilities, and life-changing student experiences. The university is based in the middle of the dynamic city of Sydney, which is not only a fantastic beachside location, but is also a great base for exploring greater Australia and neighboring countries.

SOPHOMORE YEAR

You will travel to Santiago in the Dominican Republic your sophomore year, spending one semester in this immersion, studying at the Creighton campus in Santiago. The Encuentro Dominicano program embodies the Jesuit mission of promoting justice, striving for excellence, and dedication to the

truth. Encuentro centers around travel, building community with fellow students and Dominicans and service-learning-all while experiencing the rich and vibrant culture of the Dominican Republic.

SUMMER TRAVEL

You will have a choice of two summer intensive experiences—either two Faculty- Led Programs Away (FLPA) or one FLPA and one Intensive Language Immersion Program or International Internship. These options are designed to meet your educational needs and professional goals.

GLOBAL LEARNING ON CAMPUS

You will spend six semesters on Creighton's Omaha campus as an undergraduate. While you're on campus at Creighton, your schedule will include a special companion seminar each semester to continually integrate global learning into your major. You will also have optional international opportunities available at additional costs.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Students with strong academic profiles are invited to apply to the Global Scholars Program. Due to course requirements and sequencing, only certain majors are eligible to participate in the program. Global Scholars may not be a good fit for nursing students and some pre-health majors.

PROGRAM COSTS

\$7,500 per year, in addition to tuition, fees, room and board. This cost includes all visas, flights, and health insurance involved in program-related travel, as well as specialized advising, workshops, and guest speakers, in Omaha and overseas. Students will be responsible for books and spending money.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Submission of a completed Creighton University Application for Undergraduate Admission, including all supporting materials by December 1, 2017.
- Submission of the Global Scholars Program application and all supporting materials by January 5, 2018.
- All eligible applicants are required to complete an interview. Interviews will be conducted on campus during the Special Programs Day held on Sunday, January 28, 2018. Applicants are highly encouraged to attend Special Programs Day. For students who are unable to attend, phone interviews will be available January 15-26, 2018.
